

# 2023-2024 HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE

Morris Jeff Community School is an open-access, public charter school in New Orleans, Louisiana, and welcomes learners of all backgrounds, holding each to the highest expectations. Civil Rights Activist Ruby Bridges was the first African-American student, at age six, to attend William Frantz School, which now houses our high school. Her undeniable courage and unwavering strength sparked a movement of racial integration to help change the educational system in the American South. The building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Students are provided with a deep, rich curriculum that engages them in inquiry, develops strong critical thinking skills, and challenges them to a new level of learning. Morris Jeff is diverse by design, beginning with our youngest students. Our student diversity reflects the racial and cultural makeup of New Orleans. Our mission is to prepare students of Morris Jeff to become contributing global citizens and attain the foundation needed to excel at college, career, and beyond.

Morris Jeff high school students have opportunities to travel abroad, participate in service projects both in and out of their community, and learn in classrooms alongside a diverse swath of learners. Students participate in a challenging, international education that prepares them for life beyond high school. The balance of working hard and playing hard is supported by our clubs, sports, arts, and social events that are designed for students to develop their interests beyond the classroom.

## WHAT MAKES MORRIS JEFF DIFFERENT?

Morris Jeff Community School is the only International Baccalaureate World School for Grades PK-12 in Louisiana. The curriculum is a highly rigorous and holistic program that focuses on developing writing skills, thoughtful analysis, and academic content. It includes a diverse group of students who are challenged to consider their learning through the lens of global citizenship and internationalism. All students complete the IB Middle Years Programme with a cumulative Personal Project in the 10th grade. We offer two diplomas to graduating seniors: TOPS University Diploma and the IB Diploma.
